1. You may drive off of the paved roadway to pass another vehicle:

Answer: Under no circumstances.

2. You are approaching a railroad crossing with no warning devices and are unable to see 400 feet down the tracks in one direction. The speed limit is:

Answer: 15 MPH

3. When parking your vehicle parallel to the curb on a level street:

Answer: Your wheels must be within 18 inches of the curb.

4. When merging onto the freeway you should be driving:

Answer: At or near the same speed as the traffic on the freeway.

5. When driving in fog you should use your:

Answer: Low beams.

6. A white painted curb means:

Answer: Loading zone for passengers or mail only.

7. A school bus ahead of you in your lane is stopped with red lights flashing. You should:

Answer: Stop as long as the red lights are flashing.

Answer: 25 MPH

5. You may legally block an intersection:

Answer: Under no circumstances.

6. When parking uphill on a two-way street with no curbs, your front wheels should be:

Answer: Turned to the right (away from the street).

7. With a Class C drivers license a person may drive:

Answer: A 3-axle vehicle if the Gross Vehicle Weight is less than 6,000 pounds.

8. To turn left from a multilane one-way street onto a one-way street, you should turn from:

Answer: The lane closest to the left curb.

9. If you are involved in a traffic collision, you are required to complete and submit a written report (SR1) to the DMV:

Answer: If there is property damage in excess of \$750 or if there are any injuries.

10. Roadways are the most slippery: Answer: The first rain after a dry spell.

1. You may not park your vehicle:

2. You must notify the DMV within 5 days if you:

Answer: Look to the sides of your vehicle to see what is coming.
